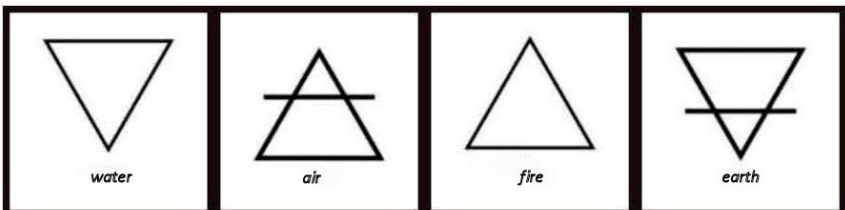
Dusty Molyneaux is the Music and Art Supervisor for the Great Falls Public Schools. In this position, he oversees 40 teachers that reach out and deliver art and music instruction to over 10,000 students in 20 buildings in the Great Falls school system. Before taking on this position, he was the band director at Great Falls High School and the Shepherd Public Schools. The GFHS Symphonic Band was invited to perform at the NW-MENC festival twice during his time there.

Dusty is the current Northwest Division of the National Association for Music Education (NW-NafME) President-Elect, and is also the Section 8 representative of the National High School Association Music (NFHS) Committee. He is also the chair of the Montana High Schools Association Music Committee. He is a past-president of the Montana Music Educators Association and Montana Bandmasters Association, and is an active trumpet player in the region (GF Symphony 2nd trumpet, GF Municipal Band and other organizations). In January of 2014 he was awarded the National Federation of High Schools Outstanding Montana Music Educator of the Year by the Montana High School Association.

Dusty earned degrees from the University of Montana (BME) and VanderCook College of Music (MME), and holds a k-12 principal endorsement from the University of Montana.

Dusty serves the community as a member of the Great Falls Symphony Board of Directors, Paris Gibson Museum of Art Board of Directors, the Mansfield Performing Arts Foundation, the Great Falls Optimist Club, and Our Savior's Lutheran Church.

James F. Rickley is presently accompanist and organist at New Hope Lutheran Church. Originally from the Pennsylvania area, he chose to expend his retirement in Great Falls. His music composition training was through the University of Cincinnati and Temple University. He served as a music teacher and school administrator in Pennsylvania, Nevada and Montana. He is the owner of the music publishing firm WayWordBound with compositional works available through the online operations of Hal Leonard Corporation.
